## Music Notes ~ A Lament for the Dead

The week's prelude is *Elegy* by George Thalben-Ball (1896-1987). When he was just 14, Thalben-Ball entered the Royal College of Music. He was an extraordinary performer, being the first English soloist for a performance of Rachmaninoff's Piano Concerto no. 3 at the young age of 19. His best-known organ work, which was played at the funeral of Diana, Princess of Wales, *Elegy* was originally an improvisation that was played on a live BBC program during World War II. The improvisation was written down after the service in response to several requests for the sheet music. Although Thalben-Ball's music is not based on an elegy—a sorrowful or melancholy poem—it functions as a musical lament for the dead. ~ Dr. Brett Judson, Director of Music
