## Ministry Spotlight: Audio/Visual (A/V)

The A/V ministry is responsible for the managing the sound and broadcast of Trinity's services. A/V volunteers work from the loft, operating the sound board at each service, and managing the camera and feed for services streamed to Facebook.

Members of the A/V ministry are generally tech-savvy, but no previous knowledge or experience is required. New volunteers work with experienced members of the team until they are comfortable running the A/V system by themselves.

Volunteers typically serve for one to two services per month, arriving twenty minutes early and staying a few minutes after.

## Music Notes ~ Harry T. Burleigh Integrates the Choir

This week's closing hymn is "In Christ there is no East or West," a spiritual adapted by Harry T. Burleigh. Burleigh named the tune MCKEE after the Rev. Elmer M. McKee, rector of St. George's Church in New York. In 1894, Burleigh began his service as a paid soloist for St. George's, serving there for over 50 years. Initially, Burleigh faced racial discrimination because St. George's was an all-white congregation. Like other white Episcopal congregations in New York City, St. George's did not yet allow black people to join them for worship. Interestingly, it was parishioner and vestryman J.P. Morgan who ensured that Burleigh would stay at St. George's despite the opposition and challenges. As a composer, Burleigh is remembered fondly for his many arrangements of spirituals, making them accessible to and beloved by congregational members and audiences. ~ Dr. Brett Judson, Director of Music

Our word of the week is [sanctuary](#). While it is often used by many Christians to refer to the entire room in which worship occurs, we use it to refer more precisely to the area around the altar. If we want to be really precise, we might refer to the entire area behind the altar rail as the [chancel](#), and the tiled platform on which the altar is sited as the sanctuary.
