Shrove Tuesday is next Tuesday, February 21st. We'll have our annual pancake supper in the Parish Hall beginning at 5:30pm. Supper is free, we just want to enjoy your fellowship! Ash Wednesday services on Wednesday the 22nd will be held in the church at noon and at 7pm; both services will include Mtr. Libby preaching, the imposition of ashes, and Holy Communion. The choir will sing at the 7pm service. Just a reminder, this is a “day of obligation,” meaning that you are expected to attend an Ash Wednesday service, either here or somewhere else; if you aren’t able to attend one of ours and need help finding one near your workplace, on your trip, or whatever, let [Fr. Todd](#) or [Mtr. Anne](#) know and they’ll be happy to help. And our services will be broadcast on our Facebook page, so you can always tune in there! If for health reasons you are unable to attend a service in person, but you would still like the imposition of ashes, let us know – we can arrange to meet you outside the church to impose ashes on Wednesday afternoon after you participate in the noon service online.

Burying Alleluias

During Sunday School on February 19th, our Director of Children’s and Youth Ministries Travis will lead the Sunday School children and youth in the annual tradition of burying the alleluias. We don’t say the word alleluia in the liturgy during Lent, so we help the kids learn this by burying the alleluias on the final Sunday before Lent begins; on Easter Sunday, the alleluias are resurrected as the opening of the Easter egg hunt.

Easter Outreach

It’s already time to think about feeding our hungry neighbors on Easter. This year, we are again supplying hams for the Twin Lakes Food Bank. Shoppers, bring your 7-9lb bone-in ham (spiral-sliced preferred!) to the Parish Hall kitchen during coffee hour on February 19th or 26th. If you forget to pick one up when you go shopping, you can sponsor a ham with a donation of \$35 (memo the check or envelope Easter Hams).

We'll also be helping the Orangevale-Fair Oaks Food Bank to provide Easter baskets to the children served there. You can sponsor a basket, filled with treats but also with necessities, for \$20 (memo the check or envelope Easter Baskets).

If you're making a monetary donation, you can write a check to the church (just memo it Easter Hams or Baskets), use one of the pew envelopes, or use one of the envelopes the Outreach Committee is printing up – ask for one from an usher or at coffee hour.
