This week's prelude is a setting of "Rockingham" (Hymnal \#321) by British composer Kenneth Leighton. Born in an industrial northern town in England, Leighton rose to prominence, holding significant University positions at the University of Leeds and the University of Edinburgh. He enjoyed teaching harmony and counterpoint, in addition to some peace and quiet with his family. Leighton faced some challenges with administrative duties and divorce and remarriage. Although not a regular churchgoer, Leighton had a great love of literature and nature, which made its way into his music. He even loved walking his dog in the Scottish Highlands.
